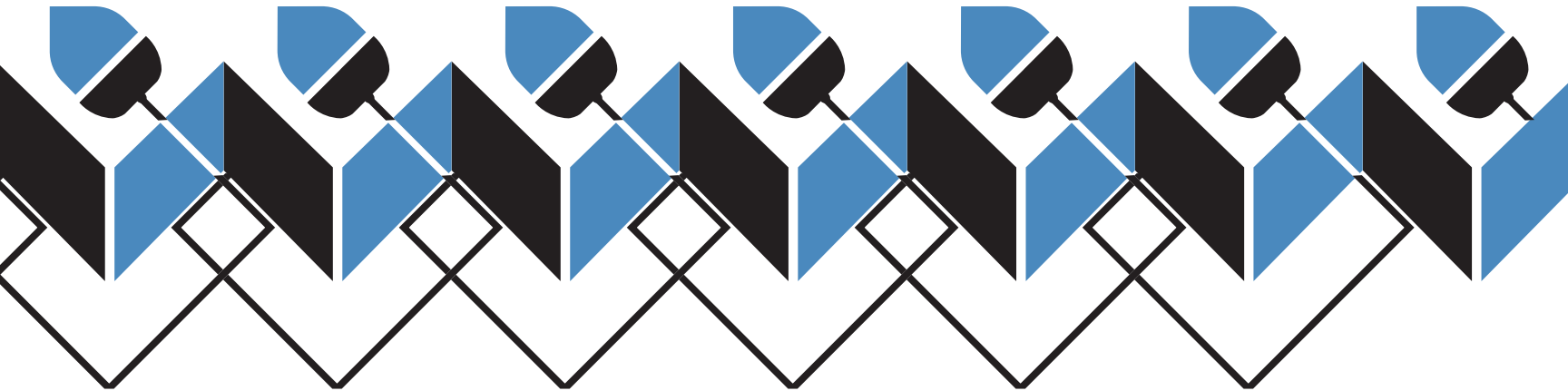

Programs can be viewed at the Archive, or, for a fee, copies of the tapes can be made and loaned.

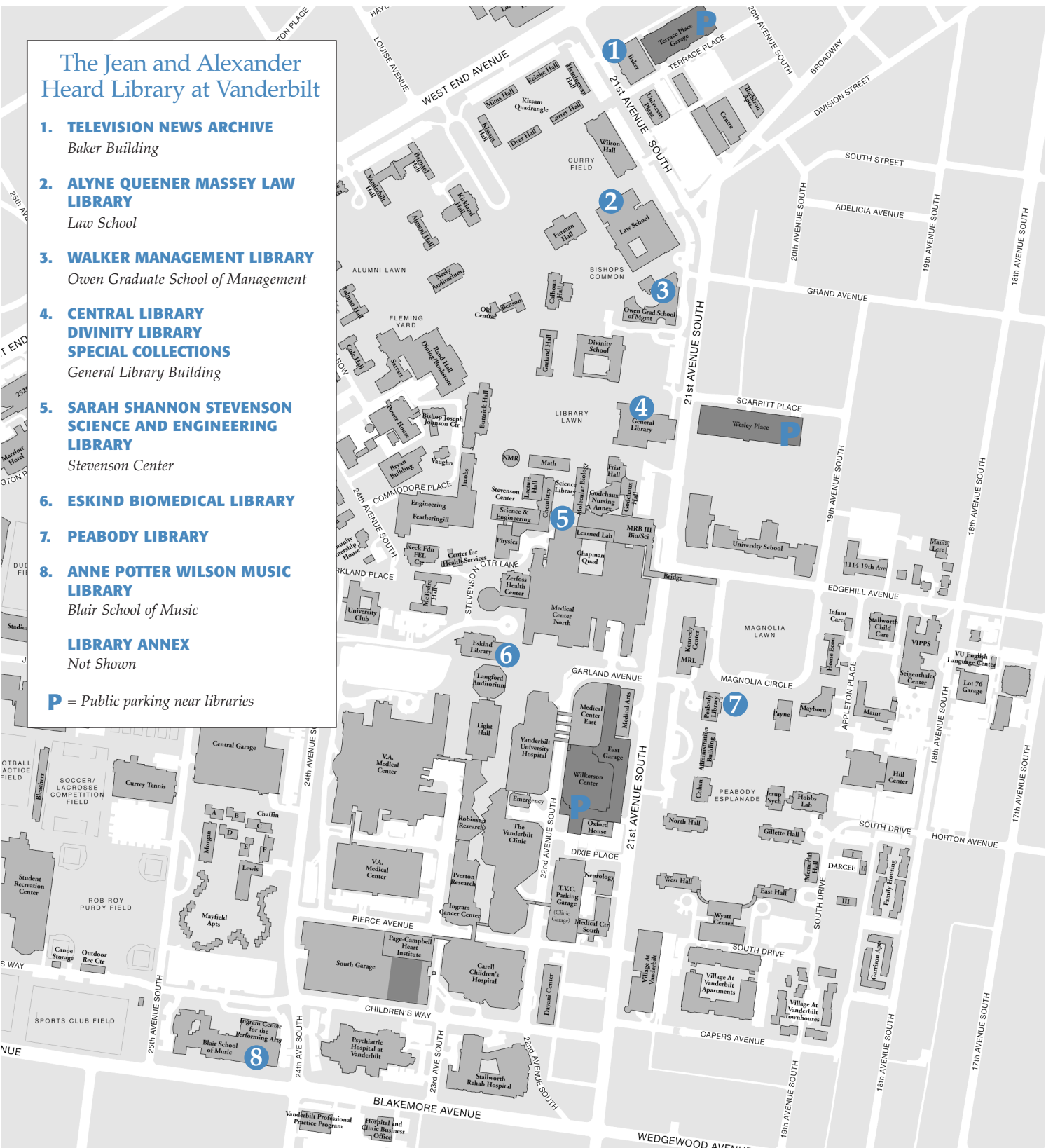

## LIBRARY FACILITIES

The **Vanderbilt University Library system** consists of

- Eight campus libraries
- Special Collections and University Archives
- The Television News Archive
- The Government Documents repository
- A storage facility called the Annex

Vanderbilt students, faculty, staff, and alumni have reading and borrowing privileges in all eight campus libraries upon presentation of a valid university identification card.
