APPLIES TO	Artistic or intellectual expressions: literature, musical or dramatic works, all forms of visual art	Invention or discovery of a process, machine, manufactured item, or composition of matter	Symbol, logo, slogan, phrase, or brand name that identifies a product or service
DOES NOT APPLY TO	Ideas, slogans, titles, short phrases, names	Ideas; inventions that are obvious or only substitute a new material or ingredient	Personal surnames, generic terms, mere descriptions of the product
TO QUALIFY	Work must be expressed in concrete form: written, recorded, illustrated, filmed, etc.	Invention must be original and useful; must actually exist and work as described	Goods or services must be marketed across state lines
RIGHTS GRANTED	Right to reproduce, distribute, publicly perform, or display the work	Right to exclude others from making, using, or selling the invention	Right to use the mark in commerce and to exclude others from doing so
RIGHTS BEGIN	When work is created in a fixed form	When patent is issued	From time of first commercial use
DURATION	Creator's life + 70 years	20 years	As long as mark is in use
